

ATTENTION SNAP RECIPIENTS

You will likely see an increase in your benefits this month!

This is not a mistake!

The new COVID Relief bill **increases SNAP payments by 15%**, or an average of \$27 a month per person, from
January 1 through June 30, 2021

- If you are receiving the new \$300/week for Pandemic Unemployment Compensation, that extra benefit will **not** count as income for SNAP
- The bill provides another round of stimulus payments of **\$600** for individuals making less than \$75,000/year, plus \$600 per child under 17
- Stimulus payments will **not** count against other benefits funded by the federal government including MaineCare, SNAP, TANF, SSI, LIHEAP, or federal housing assistance like Section 8
